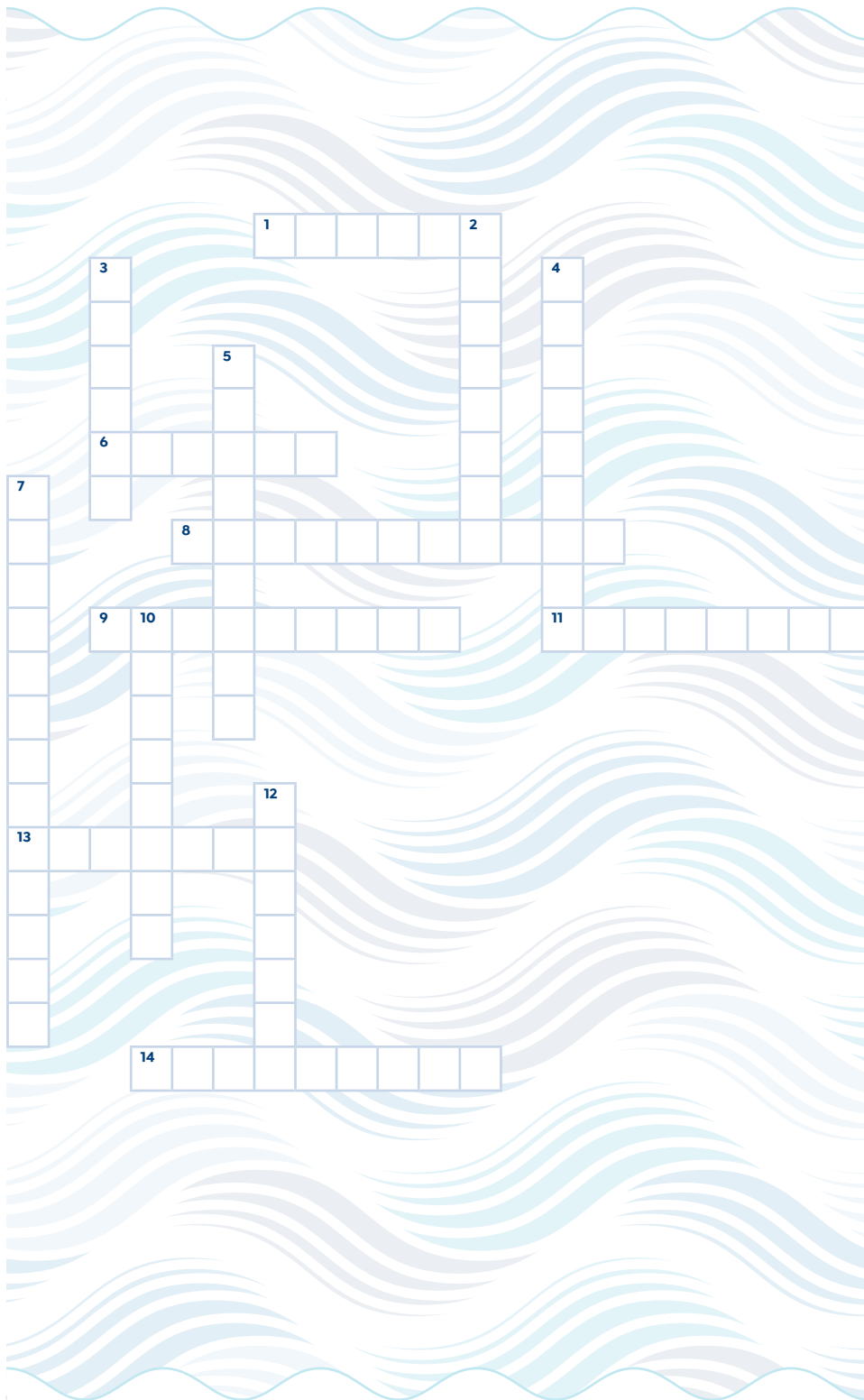


Crossword Puzzle
